

## DOOR ENTRY USING YOUR BT HANDSETS

The BT1 Telephone Interface offers the convenience of operating a door entry system from an existing BT style telephone without interfering with its normal usage. All types of domestic telephones are compatible with the BT1 including hands-free, loud speaking, large button with flashing light for call alert and cordless DECT telephones which are of great benefit to those people with limited mobility.



The interface is housed in an attractive and discreet ABS plastic enclosure which is designed for wall mounting in any indoor location, preferably next to the master telephone socket and a power point. A maximum of 3 telephones (equivalent to a REN of 3) can be con-



Interface Unit

When a call is made from the entrance panel the phone will ring for a maximum of 30 seconds, a ringing tone will be heard at the panel. When the phone is picked up the visitor can converse with the resident. If the caller is welcome the lock release can be operated by pressing the 1 key to allow access. The door will be released for 3 seconds, during which time beeps will be heard at the entrance and at the phone. For an incoming BT call the phone will ring twice and a call from the door the phone will ring three times.

If a resident is conversing with a visitor and an external phone call is received a beep will be heard in the earpiece. Pressing the \* key switches between the visitor and external phone line. When the visitor is selected the person on the other end of the line will hear an 'on hold' melody. When the phone line is selected a short warning beep is given..
